### Young

Robert C. Young, one of Carlisle's best known colored citizens, Lincoln Street, died Monday evening about six o'clock from a complication of diseases, aged about 75 years. He was born in Virginia during the days of slavery and lived here for more than half a century. He was a janitor at Dickinson College for more than a quarter of a century. He was a member of Shiloh Baptist Church being one of the first members of the organization, and was always a staunch supporter of it. He is survived by the following children; Mrs. John H. Gantz, Lincoln Street, with whom he made his home; Prof. James G. Young, a teacher in the public schools of Carlisle; Robert G. Young, of West Newton, Mass.; George F., Sommerville, Mass.; Harry A., New Brighton, Pa.; Joseph F., Toledo, O. Mr. Young was active in any work tending for the uplift of his race. He was popular among a large number of Dickinson students and will be well remembered by alumni all over the country. Funeral services Thursday afternoon at two-thirty in Shiloh Baptist Church; interment in Union Cemetery.
