

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS
AGO OUR FATHERS BROUGHT YEARS
ON THIS CONTINENT A NEW NATION
CONCEIVED IN LIBERTY AND DEDICATED TO THE PROPOSITION THAT ALL TED TO THE PROPOSITION THAT ALL MEN ARE CREATED EQUAL NOW WE ARE ENGAGED IN A GREAT CIVIL WAR TESTING WHETHER THAT NATION OR ANY NATION SO CON-CEIVED AND SO DEDICATED CAN LONG ENDURE . WE ARE MET ON A GREAT BATTLEFIELD OF THAT WAR . WE HAVE COME TO DEDICATE A PORTION OF THAT FIELD AS A FINAL RESTING PLACE FOR THOSE WHO HERE GAV THEIR LIVES THAT THAT NATION MIGHT LIVE : IT IS ALTOGETHER FIT-TING AND PROPER THAT WE SHOULD DO THIS - BUT IN A LARGER SENSE

IT IS FOR US THE LIVING RATHER TO BE DEDICATED HERE TO THE UNFINISHED WORK WHICH THEY WHO FOUGHT HERE HAVE THUS FAR SO NOBLY ADVANCED . IT IS RATHER FOR US TO BE HERE DEDICATED TO THE GREAT TASK REMAINING BEFORE US-THAT FROM THESE HONORED DEAD WE TAKE INCREASED DEVOTION TO THAT CAUSE FOR WHICH THEY GAVE THE LAST FULL MEASURE OF DEVOTION -THAT WE HERE HIGHLY RESOLVE THAT THESE DEAD SHALL NOT HAVE DIED IN VAIN-THAT THIS NATION UNDER GOD SHALL HAVE A NEW BIRTH OF FREEDOM-AND THAT GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE BY THE PEOPLE FOR THE PEOPLE SHALL NOT PERISH FROM THE EARTH.






